I have always used mixed media, printmaking, photography, and painting as a way of expressing myself in a tangible form. Being color-blind has posed some challenges, and has perhaps influenced my fascination with viewing my world and space foremost as combinations of patterns, shapes, and lines. My images reflect the dedication to finding the unique artistic aspect of simple objects at home or outdoors, natural or architectural, even the pavement I walk on. I find art all around me. I like to define “art” as the science of “mark-making.” Every camera click, mouse stroke, brush movement, impression, drip, cut, crease, cement, smear, scratch, squeeze or splatter is an intentional effort at making marks that deliver a message in two or three dimensions. All forms of art offer the opportunity to take an idea, view it, capture it, and alter it to produce an effect that makes it unique. The possibilities of mark-making are endless.
